

Cornelius Coleman, et al. v. RailWorks Corp., et al. Class Action Settlement

**United States District Court for the Southern District of New York
Case No. 20-cv-02428(GBD)(OTW)**

Instructions: You are eligible to submit a claim in the above-referenced class action settlement if you are a citizen or resident of the United States of America and satisfy the following requirements: (1) you are either (i) an employee, former employee, beneficiary or dependent of an employee or former employee of RailWorks Corporation and/or its subsidiaries and affiliates (“RailWorks”), and/or (ii) a vendor of RailWorks that received IRS Form 1099; and (2) your personal information may have been affected by a cyberattack that took place against RailWorks on or about January 14, 2020 (the “Security Incident”).

You must submit this form **no later than 60 days after the last date on which you expended time or May 18, 2021, whichever is later, and in no event later than April 1, 2023**, if you wish to submit a claim for reimbursement for time expended remedying issues related to identity theft directly caused by the Security Incident. You may be eligible for reimbursement of up to five (5) hours at a rate of ten dollars (\$10.00) per hour if you have first enrolled in the services provided by RailWorks through Identity Guard.
